Primary Duties and Responsibilities

The Friends of Fundy Storyteller & Content Creator performs a wide range of duties, including some or all the following:

- Writing, editing, blogging, and updating content for everything from promotion materials, newsletters to emails, websites, and blogs.
- Crafting engaging content that aligns with our organization and community goals.
- Creating social media posts and managing social accounts, including responding to user comments and questions.
- Working with team members and community partners throughout the region sharing content ideas to share the region's story.
- Monitoring website and social media metrics.
- Assisting in the coordination and delivery of programs and events.

Qualifications

- You have great verbal and written communication skills.
- You have strong computer skills, are experienced using social media platforms and love capturing moments with photographs and video.
- You are a people person and connect with folks easily.
- Your ability to speak both official languages is an asset.
- You are creative, organized and all about the details.
- You are ideally a full-time post-secondary student returning to school in the fall. This is a Canada Summer Jobs position, the successful candidate will need to meet program eligibility.
- You have a valid driver's license and a reliable vehicle with appropriate insurance.

Work Environment:

- The primary location will be the Village of Alma and you will also visit communities throughout the rural Upper Bay of Fundy region.
- Depending on the day, we sit, stand and/or walk for extended periods of time.
